VOLUNTEER BILL OF RIGHTS

*I have the **RIGHT** to . . .*

- **Have my volunteer experience in the church encourage a healthy relationship with Jesus Christ.**
- **Use my God-given abilities, skills, and passions in significant ministry that gives something to the body of Christ.**

I have a RIGHT to:

- **Be placed in a ministry position role based on my gifts and abilities, not my church's need to find warm bodies.**
- **Have a job description that provides me with the information I need to know.**
- **Be provided with the resources and training I need to be successful.**

And finally, *I have the RIGHT to:*

- Receive regular feedback sessions with the ministry leader so I can know how I am doing, how I can improve, and have the opportunity to discuss my questions and concerns.**
- Volunteer because I enjoy serving others, serving God, and serving my church.**
