

PROVIDING AID TO OUR BROTHERS AND SISTERS IN TURKEY AND SYRIA

On Monday, Feb. 6, a 7.8 magnitude earthquake devastated large areas of Turkey and Syria. The death toll has surpassed 36,000 and continues to climb. The earthquake is the worst to strike Turkey this century. Later that day, the region experienced a second magnitude 7.7 quake. The funds will be used to support the efforts of Catholic Relief Services as they assist local partners in Syria and Turkey with Caritas Turkey, Caritas Syria in Aleppo and Lattakia – where extensive damage has been reported – and other local partners.
