#### **SPECIAL ELECTION IN OHIO**

As you likely know, there will be a special election in Ohio on August 8, 2023 for the citizens of Ohio to vote on **Issue 1**. While the bishops of Ohio are not taking a position on Issue 1 as it contains no direct moral content, it is important to give non-partisan information intended to help the voter understand what is at stake. In that light the bishops pass along this information: Issue 1 will increase the threshold required for any proposed amendment to the Constitution of Ohio from a simple majority vote to at least a 60% majority vote in order to pass. Therefore, a "yes" vote on issue 1 will make it more difficult to pass any future amendment to the Constitution of Ohio, including this November's ballot initiative seeking an abortion rights constitutional amendment that expands and enshrines abortion at the expense of protections of preborn children and women. A "no" vote on issue 1 will maintain the current threshold, making it easier to pass an amendment to Ohio's constitution, including the one coming this November on the abortion expansion amendment.

If you are NOT registered to vote, or if you need to update your records, please seriously consider doing so by the July 9 deadline.

during the presidency of James <u>Buchanan</u>, St. Mary Church is <u>one hundred sixty</u> four years old! Its first pastor was Fr. <u>Schiff</u>. St. Mary is known for its landmark <u>twin towers</u> and its shining Christmas star.

Founded in 1901
during the fateful
presidency of William McKinley, Holy
Angels is one hundred twenty two
years old. Its first
pastor was Fr. Neville. Holy Angels
works closely with
the University of
Dayton.

Founded in 1913 during the presidency of Woodrow <u>Wilson</u> and the year of the <u>great flood</u> in Dayton, St. Anthony is <u>one hundred ten</u> years old. Its first pastor was Fr. <u>Kuenle</u>. St. Charles and St. Anthony were considered for its namesake, and St. Anthony won!

Founded in 1938 during the presidency of Franklin <u>Roosevelt</u>, Our Lady of the Immaculate Conception Church is <u>eighty five</u> years old. Its first pastor was Fr. <u>Rauscher</u>, and shortly after his appointment, the parish bought land that was home to a former **bowling alley** on Smithville and Watervliet. The church now houses over 1900 **organ pipes!** 

St. Helen, founded in 1953 during the presidency of Dwight <u>Fisenhower</u>, is the "baby" of the bunch at **seventy** years old. Its first pastor was Fr. <u>Krusling</u>, and the church was built on a field of <u>timothy grass</u>. The church is built in the shape of an upside down fishing boat, and it is known for its memorable corpus on the crucifix.

The Dayton <u>Hispanic</u> community is a key part of our family. During the year we celebrate <u>quinceanera</u>s for young ladies' 15th birthdays, <u>Las Posadas</u> at Christmas, and <u>Three Kings</u> or Dia de los Reyes on Epiphany when gifts are given to young children.
