Lord, my God,


it is . . . time for me to begin my service. Help me, I pray, to perform my appointed task with dignity but also with great humility.

hen Russia invaded Ukraine in February 2022, a humanitarian crisis began for Ukrainians, whose lives were shattered by the violence of war. Many left their homes in eastern cities in Ukraine for cities in the west, such as Lviv, farther from the most intense fighting. From the beginning of the war, the Holy Father pleaded for an end to the violence and expressed his love and concern for the Ukrainian people who were its victims. In solidarity with the victims of war, the papal almoner, Cardinal Konrad Krajewski, made two visits to Ukraine in March 2022. He first visited the cities of Rivne and Zhovka and other regions directly affected by the early conflict. He returned to Ukraine to celebrate Mass in the cathedral in Lviv and to deliver an ambulance donated by the Holy Father to the Center for Mother and Child Health to assist children displaced by the war.

The Holy Father's charitable outreach to victims of war, migrants and refugees, and the poor affected by illness and natural disasters is supported by contributions to the Peter's Pence Collection. When you participate in the collection, you join Catholics across the globe in supporting the pope's mission of mercy as well as the activities of the Holy See's dicasteries that assist his ministry.

Support for such papal efforts is rooted in the scriptural message to take care of the poor and expresses unity with

the Holy Father in two ways: through the ongoing activities of the Holy See and through the charitable works of the Holy Father on behalf of those most in need.



uando Rusia invadió Ucrania en febrero del 2022, empezó una crisis humanitaria para los ucranianos cuyas vidas han sido destrozadas por la violencia de la guerra. Muchos de ellos dejaron sus hogares en ciudades al este de Ucrania y huyeron hacia el oeste, a ciudades como Lviv, lejos de las luchas más intensas. Desde el inicio de la guerra, el Santo Padre suplicó por el fin de la violencia y expresó su amor y preocupación por las víctimas, los habitantes de Ucrania. En solidaridad con las víctimas de la guerra, el limosnero papal, Cardenal Konrad Krajewski, realizó dos visitas a Ucrania en marzo del 2022. Primero, visitó las ciudades de Rivne y Zhovka y otras regiones que fueron directamente afectadas al principio del conflicto. Luego, retornó a Ucrania para celebrar una Misa en la Catedral de Lviv y para hacer entrega de una ambulancia donada por el Santo Padre al Centro de Salud Materno Infantil para ayudar a los niños desplazados por la guerra.

El alcance caritativo del Santo Padre a las víctimas de guerra, a los migrantes y refugiados y a los pobres afectados por enfermedades y desastres naturales es financiado por las contribuciones a la Colecta Peter's Pence. Cuando ustedes participan en la colecta, se unen a los católicos en todo el mundo al apoyar la misión de misericordia del Papa y las actividades de los dicasterios de la Santa Sede que lo asisten en su ministerio.
