ST. HELEN ST. VINCENT DE PAUL REPORT

St. Helen SVdP has been very busy support our neighbors through telephone interviews, home visits, financial assistance, and referrals. From January 1st through June 30th, St. Helen Conference responded to 466 calls, providing referrals to 204 callers and financial assistance to 179 households and food to 46 households. The conference members logged 1,381 hours of service in support of our mission to our neighbors. Total spent on financial assistance \$28,166.91.

Recently, a family with 6 children called for utility assistance. Both adults had been working, but the wife lost her job and was out of work for 2 months. She just started a new job with reduced pay, but the work experience will help her as she is also earning a degree in nursing. They had been able to keep up with rent but fell behind with their utility bills. St. Helen SVdP Conference was able to assist with the bills. Both parents were very appreciative and feel they will be able to pay all their expenses going forward.



SafeParish Update: Acknowledgement Required

English: The Archdiocese of Cincinnati, in keeping with its policies, has completed the five-year revision of the Decree on Child Protection. We anticipate the revised Decree will be available for download and acknowledgment on the SafeParish website on or about July 1, 2023. • Each user with a SafeParish account will need to download, acknowledge to have read, and agree to abide by the requirements of the revised Decree. • If this is not completed within 30 days of the promulgation of the Decree by the Archbishop, the user's SafeParish account will show as pending until the user completes the acknowledgement. • Users with pending SafeParish accounts are not permitted to work or volunteer with youth until they have met all the child protection requirements and their SafeParish account is approved. Please contact your parish or school safe environment coordinator with any questions.
