FINAL REMINDER FOR SAFE PARISH CHILD PROTECTION DECREE ACKNOWLEDGEMENT

The Archdiocese of Cincinnati, in keeping with its policies, has completed the five-year revision of the Decree on Child Protection. We anticipate the revised Decree is available for download and acknowledgment on the SafeParish website . Each user with a SafeParish account will need to download, acknowledge to have read, and agree to abide by the requirements of the revised Decree. If this is not completed within 30 days of the promulgation of the Decree by the Archbishop, the user's SafeParish account will show as pending until the user completes the acknowledgement. Users with pending SafeParish accounts are not permitted to work or volunteer with youth until they have met all the child protection requirements and their SafeParish account is approved. Please contact your parish or school safe environment coordinator with any questions.

Pastor updates on Beacons of Light from Fr. Satish NE7 Family of Parishes

July 22/23, 2023

Dear Parishioners.

In January this year, I had written a letter updating the parishioners of the NE7 Family of Parishes (FoP) about the Beacons of Light plan for 2023. Halfway through the year, I would like to take the opportunity to make you aware of the activities and plan for the second half of this year.

Whereas some of these activities are for parish leadership teams, the upcoming FoP Retreat is for all parishioners. The retreat entitled, "One Bread, One Body" will focus on the Eucharist as our bond of unity. It will serve two purposes. First, it will prepare the parishes for the National Eucharistic Revival in Indianapolis in 2024. It will also renew and deeper our faith in the most central aspect of our Catholic life - the Eucharist.

Here are some of the events planned in the coming months:

On Saturday, August 26, 2023, there will be a retreat for all Parish Staff, Parish Pastoral Council members, Parish Finance Commission members, and School Principals. This Retreat will lay the spiritual and theological foundation for our leadership teams.

On Saturday, September 9, 2022, there will be a retreat for all the parishioners of our 5 parishes and the Dayton Hispanic Community. As mentioned above, this retreat will focus on NE7 FoP being a Eucharistic community. This will also be a remote preparation for the Eucharistic Congress. By mid-August you will receive a letter in the mail with an invitation and a registration form. I hope that many of you will attend this retreat and become part of a vision for a Eucharistic community.

We will also form a FoP Pastoral Council representing all the 5 parishes and the Dayton Hispanic Community. The initial configuration of the FoP Pastoral Council will be composed of the Chair and Vice Chair of Parish Councils, the Finance Commission Chair, the Parish Business Managers, the School Principals, and one at large member from every parish to be appointed by the Pastor.

On October 4, 2023, we will have the 1st meeting of FoP Parish Pastoral Council. At this meeting discussions will begin for a name, a website, a common bulletin, and becoming familiar with the ground reality of every parish.

On December 6, 2023, we will have the 2nd meeting of the FoP Parish Pastoral Council. In this meeting we will have more detailed discussions about beginning the process of becoming one parish. The hope also is that the key leaders for the 6 areas of the Beacons of Light plan will also emerge from this meeting.

From here on the FoP Parish Pastoral Council will meet on the 1st Wednesday of every other month. The rest of the plans for our Family of Parishes will emerge from these meetings. All decisions will be made in a spirit of discussions and consultations.

May I request your most sincere prayer as we begin the new phase of the Beacons of Light initiative. May we all be open to the work the Holy Spirit among us. And may we be open to each other as we become one parish family.


