## FAITH FORMATION

### Lenten Discipleship Challenge

#### Week of Ash Wednesday February 18-21

In 1 Corinthians (6:1-2) Paul quotes the prophet Isaiah (49:8), “In a favorable time I have heard you; on the day of salvation I have chosen you.” Choices is a theme throughout this brief week. The author of Deuteronomy (30:19-20) bids us to choose life, while Luke (9:24-25) encourages us that to lose our lives is the ultimate gain. Isaiah (58:1, 5-11) challenges the right kind of choosing: removing malice, so the light might rise against the darkness. For darkness cannot exist against the light. The light always wins. Always. In the coming seven weeks this bulletin will feature meditations composed by parishioners throughout our Pan de Vida/ Bread of Life Family, employing the scripture readings prescribed by the church each day, including practical ideas to apply the scripture of the day in the here and now.

#### Ash Wednesday, February 18 (Joel 2:12-18; 2 Corinthians 5:20-6:2; Matthew 6:1-16, 16-18)

We are invited to pray loudly by being quiet. The readings of Ash Wednesday present a kind of contradiction, asking us to “blow the trumpets” while also calling us to keep our devotion hidden. What we are truly called to do is to connect our mouths, hearts, and hands. Our words and actions should reflect what lives within our hearts. Christ calls us to authentically serve God and to be true neighbors to one another. Our faith is not a performance, but an authentic choice to show our commitment to God’s love. So let us pour our hearts out this Lenten season and love as though only God is watching. During this season, try at least one new prayer opportunity so you can grow deeper in relationship with God.

#### Thursday after Ash Wednesday, February 19 (Deuteronomy 30:15-20; Luke 9:22-25)

Every day our life is filled with choices. Eggs or cereal for breakfast, reading or watching television in our free time are a few of the simple decisions that we choose with little consideration. But over time these small choices create a larger picture of who we are, how we use our time and resources, and the ways we are living out our faith. Jesus reminds us in today’s gospel that following him involves self-sacrifice and service to others (Luke 9:23). Through the course of this day, become more mindful of your decisions, and choose one act that you can do to help someone in need. Follow through with this course of action even if this involves giving up something that you hold dear- your time, your talent or your possessions.

#### Friday after Ash Wednesday, February 20 (Isaiah 58:1-9a; Matthew 9:14-15)

In Isaiah 58:1-9a, we find the Israelites participating in outward acts of fasting, but God rejects their efforts as the fruit of their fasting does not reflect true justice, compassion, or care for others. Our choice to fast must be rooted in genuine love for God and God’s people. Matthew 9:14-15 reminds us that we sometimes have to look deeper than just religious tradition or expectation in our fasting. We must be mindful of how God is calling us in a particular time or place to be present with him and his people. Our Lenten sorrow can be rich. Today, let us also choose to embrace deep joy wherever the Bridegroom is most present in your life.

#### Saturday after Ash Wednesday, February 21 (Isaiah 58:9b-14; Luke 5:27-32)

Today’s psalm refrain is, “Teach me your ways O LORD, that I may walk in your truth” (Psalm 86:1-2). But how? Our readings outline the LORD’s ways. To paraphrase, he tells us to choose to stop lying, accusing, judging and to cease all maliciousness; and give the Sabbath to the LORD (Isaiah 58:9-10, 13). This is how we are to be the LORD’s light. The LORD shows forth his light as he dines with tax collectors and is challenged as to how could sit with the less desirable. His response reminds us how to act. He says, “Those who are healthy do not need a physician ..., I have not come to call the righteous to repentance but sinners” (John 5:32). As we enter into the first Sabbath of Lent tomorrow, think of someone you have judged and plan for a way to “dine” or simply be present to them, as Jesus did.

This has implications for Christian discipleship today.

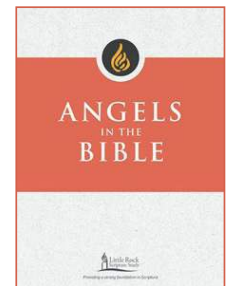
