**Change of Sunday Mass time at Holy Angels Parish****Holy Angels**

For various practical and pastoral reasons, Sunday Mass time at Holy Angels will change from 10:30 am to 10:45 am beginning September 1, 2024. Practically, this change will ensure adequate time for the safe travel of the priests and other liturgical ministers from earlier Masses in other parishes. Moreover, the choir members and Fr. Len have suggested this modification to assist our new music minister who serves both St. Anthony and Holy Angels. Pastorally, it allows time for the priests to be present to the congregation rather than arriving late or rushing off. Finally, and most importantly, it assures that the celebration of the Eucharist, which is "the source and summit of our Christian life," is properly and solemnly celebrated.

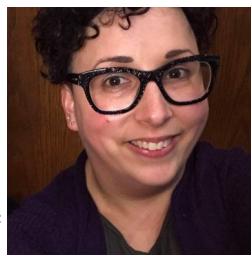

Christine's RCIA Story**

My name is Christine Hamilton. I was born and raised Catholic but never completed Confirmation. I fell away from the Catholic Church after my family moved cities back in high school around 2006. In 2016, I married my husband, who I met at the University of Dayton. In fall of 2019, my mom was diagnosed with stage four lung cancer, and my husband and I became pregnant. Shortly after Christmas, I miscarried. I miscarried again in mid 2020. After seeking medical help and receiving no answers, we were fortunate enough to get pregnant in August 2021. We were having a baby boy. On February 17th, 2021, I was told that the baby had no heartbeat and Baby Hudson was born into heaven. Seven months later, after some hurtful words were said to me from some people in my life, I decided it was time to look to God for some answers and started attending Mass at Holy Angels. In March 2022 after arriving home from vacation, I found out I was pregnant with a baby girl, and we were beyond excited. Our prayers were answered, but little did we know that our daughter, Lynlee Grace would soon pass at 28 weeks on September 2nd. I was still questioning why God would create so much trauma in our lives. I found an amazing infant loss group based out of a Catholic Church in Centerville. It showed me that while I may not understand why these things are happening to my husband and I, that God has bigger plans for us and our future family. The doctors finally told us that I probably would not be able to carry a baby to full term and that they would all more than likely end in stillbirths. We then began our discernment journey as to how we will have a child. During that time, my mom passed away from her cancer on February 15th, 2023. While going through this journey without my mom was difficult, I clung to God and the church through it all. Going to Mass every week, the Gospel seemed to speak to me about what was happening in my life at that time. I was ready to take the next step to becoming a Confirmed Catholic and filling that hole that was in my heart and soul. RCIA taught me why Catholics believe what they do and what it means to be a part of One Church. By the grace of God, my son was born March 9th, 2024, seven weeks early with no medical issues. God had his hand in this entire journey and guided me to join RCIA. Completing my journey to becoming fully Catholic was one that I will forever be blessed with. I would encourage anyone wanting to finish becoming Catholic or joining the Catholic Church, to take the leap and learn more about the Catholic faith.

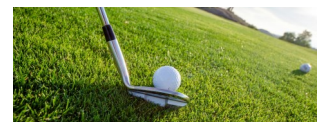

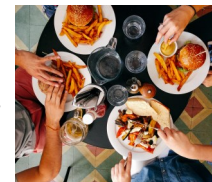

Dear friends,

Starting on July 28, 2024, and continuing over five weekends, we will hear most of chapter six of John's Gospel proclaimed at Mass. These passages are sometimes collectively referred to as "*The Bread of Life Discourse.*" While as Catholics we hear the same cycle of readings on Sundays every three years, we find ourselves at a different place in our lives each time, allowing new insights to be revealed and different implications of the Sacred Scriptures to be drawn in our lives. With the cycle of readings aligning the way it happened, we have a tremendous opportunity over these five weeks to prayerfully reflect together on the Bread of Life Discourse (which is the origin of our Family of Parishes' name) and ponder together what these passages might be calling our **entire** Family of Parishes to.

What are the implications for us as a Family of Parishes to...

- "...not work for the food that perishes but for eternal life..." (John 6:27a)?
- follow the one who came "...not to do my own will, but the will of him who sent me..." (John 6:38b)?
- be those who abide in Christ and have Christ abide in them (cf. John 6:56)?


As we participate together at Mass from July 28 through August 25, the homilies will offer practical implications for what this Bread of Life Discourse has for us together as a Family of Parishes. We will pray our One Bread, One Body Family of Parishes Prayer. There will also be special petitions for our Family of Parishes.

The first passage we will hear proclaimed is the multiplication of fishes and loaves, where the small contribution of two fish and five loaves of bread feeds 5,000. This has inspired us to establish a challenge for the Bread of Life Family of Parishes. Can we, as the Bread of Life Family of Parishes, collect 5,000 non-perishable food items over the course of the five weeks the Bread of Life Discourse is proclaimed?


From July 28 through August 25, there will be a designated collection point at each location within the Bread of Life Family of Parishes. We will have weekly updates in the bulletin of the number of items collected and the collected food will be distributed by the charitable organizations already operating in the Bread of Life Family of Parishes.

May we make these five weeks together an opportunity to begin to discover what it means to **be** the Bread of Life Family of Parishes.
